AMENDED
ORDINANCE NO. 00-008

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT, TERMS, AND DUTIES
OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY HEARING EXAMINERS

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.02.030, adopted by Ordinance No. 80-115 on December 29, 1980, is amended to read:

2.02.030 Appointment and terms.

The council shall appoint the examiner and any deputy examiners for terms which shall initially expire one year following the date of original appointment and thereafter expire ~~((four))~~ two years following the date of each reappointment. The council may also by professional service contract appoint for terms and functions deemed appropriate by the council, examiners pro tem to serve in the event of absence or inability to act of the examiner or deputy examiners.

Section 2. Snohomish County Code Section 2.02.090, adopted by Ordinance No. 80-115 on December 29, 1980, is amended to read:

2.02.090 Rules.


The examiner shall have the power to ~~((proscribe))~~ adopt and amend rules ~~((for))~~ governing the scheduling and conduct of hearings and other procedural matters related to the duties of his or her office. Such rules may provide for cross examination of witnesses. The examiner shall within five days after adoption or amendment of any such rule transmit a copy of such rule to the clerk of the council for council review, which rule shall remain in effect unless rejected or modified by the council. The council may by motion modify or reject the rule. The examiner shall incorporate any such action within ten days after adoption of the motion.


Section 3. Review of existing rules. The examiner shall review and if the examiner deems appropriate modify any rules adopted under SCC 2.02.090 prior to the effective date of this section. Within 90 days after the effective date of this section the examiner shall provide copies of such rules (as modified) to the council for its review in accordance with SCC 2.02.090.

Section 4. Effective date. Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance shall take effect ten days after this ordinance is signed by the county executive or otherwise enacted as set out in Charter §2.110. Section 3 of this ordinance shall take effect on (~~May 1~~) June 1, 2000.


