ORDINANCE 01-031

AUTHORITY OF EXECUTIVE ELECTED OFFICIALS;
AMENDING SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE TITLE 2;
RATIFYING ACTS OF ASSESSOR, SHERIFF, AND CLERK;

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The title of Chapter 2.10 Snohomish County Code is amended to read:

Chapter 2.10

County Executive Officials

New Section. Section 2. A new section 2.10.020 is added to Snohomish County Code Chapter 2.10 as follows:

2.10.020. Assessor functions.

Except as otherwise delegated or restricted by ordinance, the county assessor shall have all the powers, authorities and duties granted to and imposed upon an assessor by state law.

New Section. Section 3. A new section 2.10.030 is added to Snohomish County Code Chapter 2.10 as follows:

2.10.030. Sheriff functions.

Except as otherwise delegated or restricted by ordinance, the county sheriff shall have all the powers, authorities and duties granted to and imposed upon a sheriff by state law.

New Section. Section 4. A new section 2.10.040 is added to Snohomish County Code Chapter 2.10 as follows:

2.10.040. Clerk functions.

Except as otherwise delegated or restricted by ordinance, the county clerk shall have all the powers, authorities and duties granted to and imposed upon a county clerk by state law.

Section 5. Ratification of Duties Performed. The council and the executive hereby ratify acts of the county assessor, county sheriff, and county clerk to the extent such acts, at the time such acts were performed, were consistent with the powers, authorities, and duties delegated to such officers in this ordinance.
