ORDINANCE NO. 01 - 071

RELATING TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY DISTRICT COURT,
CLARIFYING AND MODIFYING TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT OF
DISTRICT COURT COMMISSIONERS, AND AMENDING
SCC 2.12.100

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.100, last amended by Amended Ordinance No. 97-097 on December 10, 1997, is amended to read:

2.12.100 Authorization of court commissioners.

(1) The district court is authorized to appoint one or more district court commissioners, subject to appropriation of necessary funds pursuant to chapter 4.26 SCC. District court commissioners may be located in any electoral district as determined by the presiding judge.

(2) A district court commissioner who is employed for 20 hours per week or more is eligible for employee benefits as described in chapter 3A.06 SCC, except that a district court commissioner shall accrue and use leave with pay, including sick leave, in the same manner as a district court judge.

Section 2. Effective date and savings clause. This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2002. Vacation and sick leave accrued by a District Court Commissioner prior to the effective date of this ordinance shall be frozen for payment upon termination of county employment as provided for exempt employees in SCC 3.68.070(9)(b).


