AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 03-042

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF  
MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION;  
AMENDING CHAPTER 2.76 SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

WHEREAS, Currently, under SCC 2.76.030, terms of members of the Board of Equalization commence on the first day of July; and

WHEREAS, Under RCW 84.48.042, the Department of Revenue is to establish a school for the training of Board of Equalization members and members are required to attend such training within one year following their appointment or reappointment; and

WHEREAS, Department of Revenue training is held only in May or June of each year, and

WHEREAS, Newly appointed members of the Board of Equalization would benefit from attending such training earlier in their terms than currently occurs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.76.030, last amended by Ordinance 82-079 on August 18, 1982, is amended to read:

2.76.030 Terms - Compensation~~((e - Salaries))~~.

~~((Members of the board of equalization appointed prior to July 1, 1982 shall continue to serve until their successors are appointed. Successors to these members shall be appointed July 1, 1983.))~~ The terms of ~~((each))~~ members of the board shall commence on the first day of May and shall be for three years ~~((following their initial appointment or reappointment))~~ or until their successors are appointed. No board member shall serve more than three consecutive full terms. The members shall receive such pay and allowances as are provided by chapter 84.48 RCW and chapter 458-14 WAC.

Section 2. A new section 2.76.045 is added to Snohomish County Code Chapter 2.76 to read:

2.76.045 Vacancies

A vacancy resulting from the expiration of a term of office shall be filled by appointment to a new full term of three years. A vacancy occurring for any reason other than the expiration of a term of office shall be filled by appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term of the office being filled.

Section 3. Transition. Members of the board of equalization serving terms that commenced prior to the effective date of this ordinance shall continue to serve until their successors are appointed. Except as provided below for the filling of vacancies, following the expiration of terms that commenced prior the effective date of this ordinance, appointments shall be made to terms commencing May 1, 2004 (for current terms expiring in 2003) and May 1, 2005 (for current terms expiring in 2004).


A person appointed to fill a vacancy that exists on the effective date of this ordinance or that subsequently occurs prior to April 30, 2004, shall serve until April 30, 2004 and until the appointment of a person to a new full term commencing May 1, 2004.






