ORDINANCE NO. 04- 109

ESTABLISHING A JUVENILE COURT NONREFUNDABLE BAIL FEE;
ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 4.43 TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

WHEREAS, RCW 13.40.056 authorizes the county to impose a ten dollar nonrefundable bail fee to be paid when a juvenile charged with an offense posts a probation bond or deposits cash or posts other collateral in lieu of a bond; and

WHEREAS, RCW 13.40.056 provides that this bail fee shall be distributed to the county for costs associated with implementing chapter 395, Laws of 1995; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to impose the nonrefundable bail fee and direct its collection and use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. A new chapter is added to the Snohomish County Code to read:

CHAPTER 4.43

JUVENILE COURT
NONREFUNDABLE BAIL FEE

Sections:

4.43.010 Nonrefundable bail fee established.

4.43.020 Collection and Use of fees.

4.43.010 Nonrefundable bail fee established.

As authorized by RCW 13.40.056, when a juvenile charged with an offense posts a probation bond or deposits cash or posts other collateral in lieu of bond, ten dollars of the total amount required to be posted as bail shall be paid in cash as a nonrefundable bail fee.

4.43.020 Collection and Use of fees.

The nonrefundable bail fees imposed by section 4.43.010 shall be collected by the County Clerk and used solely to pay a portion of the county's costs associated with implementing Chapter 395, Washington Laws, 1995.
