ORDINANCE NO. 05-011

RELATING TO THE POWERS, DUTIES AND COMPOSITION
OF THE VETERANS' ASSISTANCE FUND EXECUTIVE BOARD
AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2.430 SCC

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.430.030, last amended by Amended Ordinance No. 95-088 on October 25, 1995, is amended to read:

2.430.030 Powers and ~~((Duties))~~duties of ~~((Board))~~board.

The board shall adopt policies and procedures as necessary to perform the duties of the board. Staff may be assigned by the ~~((County Executive))~~county executive from county government. The ~~((Board))~~board shall have the following powers and duties.

- (1) Recommend guidelines, policies and procedures to the ~~((Veterans Service Officer/Case Manager))~~director of the department for expenditures from the veterans' assistance fund.
- (2) Review and adjudicate all appeals from applicants who feel they were treated improperly or denied assistance unfairly in accordance with policies and procedures of the veterans' assistance fund board. Decisions on appeals will be sent to the ~~((Department))~~department, which will be responsible for notifying the appellant of the decision.
- (3) Advise the county executive and the department on the budget for the veterans' assistance fund.
- (4) Review and advise the director of the department on applications for the service officer position. The director ~~((of the department))~~ will make the final appointment after full consultation with the board~~((, and only on agreement by a majority of the board))~~.
- (5) Perform such other duties as may be requested by the department.

Section 2. Snohomish County Code Section 2.430.040, last amended by Amended Ordinance No. 95-088 on October 25, 1995, is amended to read:


2.430.040 Composition of ~~((Board))~~board.

The board shall consist of not less than one (1) and no more than two (2) representatives of each congressionally chartered veterans' organization as

defined in RCW 73.08.010, which members shall be recommended by the district commander of each veterans' organization. In addition, there shall be two veteran at-large members, which members need not be representatives of a veterans' organization but shall be veterans recruited from the community and recommended by the board. Members of the board shall be nominated by the ((County Executive))county executive ((based upon recommendations of the commander of each veteran's organization)) and appointed by the ((County Council))county council pursuant to ((Chapter))chapter 2.03 of the Snohomish County Code.
