ORDINANCE NO. 06-079

RELATING TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY ENHANCED EMERGENCY
SERVICES COMMUNICATION SYSTEM;
AMENDING CHAPTER 4.78 SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 4.78.070, last amended by Amended Ordinance 99-053, § 5, on June 23, 1999, is amended to read:

4.78.070 Enhanced emergency services communication board. The Snohomish county enhanced emergency services communication board (enhanced 911 board) is hereby established. The enhanced 911 board shall consist of two ~~((members of))~~ representatives selected by the board of directors of the southwest Snohomish county public safety communications agency (SNOCOM); ~~((selected by the SNOCOM board,))~~ two ~~((members of))~~ representatives selected by the board of directors of the Snohomish county police staff and auxiliary services center (SNOPAC); ~~((selected by the SNOPAC board,))~~ one member of the Snohomish county council selected by the council~~((,));~~ and one member appointed by the Snohomish county executive~~((, and one member appointed by the city of Marysville)).~~ One member of the Washington state patrol selected by the chief of the state patrol shall serve as an ex officio non-voting member of said board.

Section 2 Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective November 1, 2006.


