AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 08-055

RELATING TO THE GROWTH MANAGEMENT ACT, ADOPTING MAP AMENDMENTS TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY GROWTH MANAGEMENT ACT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (GMACP) TO IMPLEMENT CHANGES TO MAP 3 MUNICIPAL URBAN GROWTH AREAS (MUGA) (GPP 14 MUGA)

WHEREAS, RCW 36.70A.130 and .470 direct counties planning under the Growth Management Act (GMA) to adopt procedures for interested persons to propose amendments and revisions to the GMACP or development regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Council adopted chapter 30.74 SCC, "Growth Management Act Public Participation Program Docketing," to comply with the requirements of RCW 36.70A.130 and .470; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Council has determined that the consideration of the proposed amendments and revisions to the GMACP and development regulations would promote a county purpose as established under RCW 36.70A.130, RCW 36.70A.470 and chapter 30.74 SCC; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to chapter 30.74 SCC, PDS completed final review and evaluation of Final Docket XII, including the proposals to amend the map and text of the GMACP, and forwarded recommendations to the Snohomish County Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Planning Commission held a public hearing and received public testimony on Final Docket XII on January 22, 2008, and January 29, 2008; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2008, the Snohomish County Planning Commission deliberated on Final Docket XII at the conclusion of the public hearing and voted to recommend adoption of the proposed GMACP and regulatory amendments, with certain modifications as enumerated in its recommendation letter of February 26, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to Appendix B of the Countywide Planning Policies (CPP) authorizing this map change had not yet been adopted at the time of the Planning Commission hearing to amend GMACP Map 3 MUGA; and

WHEREAS, Countywide Planning Policy (CPP) UG-17 establishes that MUGA boundaries that are congruent with the SWUGA boundary may be amended by agreement and action by the County in consultation with the affected cities; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Brier and Bothell have consulted with the County and agreed on MUGA boundaries through Resolution 5000 (Brier) and Resolution 1209 (Bothell); and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2008, the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) of Snohomish County Tomorrow (SCT) reviewed three options to resolve MUGA gaps, overlaps, or unresolved boundaries, including: 1) retain the existing MUGAs, 2) eliminate existing MUGAs and create distinct individual UGAs for each city within the SWUGA, 3) replace existing MUGAs with a single SWUGA with no MUGAs; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2008, the PAC made a recommendation to the SCT Steering Committee to retain the existing MUGAs and to amend the MUGA map as depicted in Appendix B of the CPPs to reflect the agreement between Brier and Bothell; and

WHEREAS, on, January 23, 2008, the SCT Steering Committee reviewed the PAC recommendation and made a positive recommendation to the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Council held a public hearing on April 30, 2008, continued to May 12 and June 3, 2008, and approved the proposed amendment to Appendix B of the CPP, as recommended by the SCT Steering Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Council held a public hearing on April 30, 2008, continued to May 12 and June 3, 2008, to consider the entire record, including the Planning Commission recommendations on Final Docket XII, and to hear public testimony on this Amended Ordinance No. 08-055.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The county council makes the following findings:

- A. The county council adopts and incorporates the foregoing recitals as findings as if set forth fully herein.
- B. The amendment would amend the MUGA boundaries between the cities of Brier and Bothell as depicted in Exhibit A of this ordinance.
- C. The proposal retains the existing structure to reconcile inconsistent MUGA boundaries as described in CPP UG-17.
- 40 D. The map amendment is consistent with CPP UG-17 regarding the establishment and 41 amendments to MUGA boundaries.

- E. The map amendment is consistent with CPP OD-1 regarding development within urban growth areas, add certainty to capital facility planning and the coordinated extension of urban services.
- F. The map amendment is consistent with and implements the following GPP Objectives and Policies:
- 1. Policy IC 1.A.1 "The county shall continue participation in Snohomish County Tomorrow to reconcile, monitor and, if necessary, adjust population and employment growth targets; to resolve possible inconsistency between the local jurisdictions' plans; and to provide for common siting of essential public facilities."
- 2. Objective IC 1.B "Work with cities and towns to provide for the orderly transition of unincorporated to incorporated areas within UGAs."
 - 3. Policy IC 1.B.1 "The county shall work with cities in planning for orderly transfer of service responsibilities in anticipation of potential or planned annexations or incorporations within UGAs."
 - 4. Objective IC 1.E "Re-evaluate and, as required, modify MUGA boundaries to facilitate county planning for the development of these urban areas."
 - 5. Policy IC 1.E.2 "Inconsistencies which result in overlapping MUGAs between cities or gap areas which are not included in any city's MUGA should be reconciled between the affected cities within Snohomish County and the county as soon as is practical"
 - 6. Policy IC 1.E.3 "MUGA boundaries shall be reevaluated on a periodic basis and adjustments made as needed through the county's Comprehensive Plan amendment process."
 - 7. Policy IC 1.E.5 "MUGA boundaries that are not congruent with the SWUGA boundary may be amended by agreement and action by the affected cities and the county, consistent with 1.E.3."
- G. The county council includes in its findings and conclusions, the completed final review and evaluation of the proposal completed by PDS in accordance with 30.74 SCC and is hereby made a part of this ordinance as if set forth herein.
- H. The proposed amendment complies with the requirements of GMA, including RCW 36.70A.110(2) which states that the county shall consult with each city on the boundaries of their urban growth areas.
- I. No inconsistencies between the map amendment and GPP plan elements or development regulations have been identified.
- J. No inconsistencies between the map amendment and Countywide Planning Policies have
 been identified.
- 36 K. The map amendment complies with all requirements of the GMA.

- A. The amendment would amend the MUGA boundaries between the cities of Brier and Bothell as depicted in Exhibit A of this ordinance.
- 8 B. The proposal retains the existing structure to reconcile inconsistent MUGA boundaries as described in CPP UG-17.
- 10 C. The proposed map amendments are consistent with the following final review and evaluation criteria of chapter 30.74 SCC:
 - 1. The proposed amendments maintain consistency with other elements of the GMACP.
 - 2. All applicable elements of the GMACP support the proposed amendments.
- 14 3. The proposed amendments meet the goals, objectives, and policies of the GMACP as discussed in the specific findings.
 - 4. The proposed amendments are consistent with the CPPs.
 - 5. The proposed amendments comply with the GMA.
- 18 6. New information is available which was not considered at the time the plan or regulation was amended.
 - D. The amendments are consistent with the GMA requirement that the comprehensive plan of a county or city be an internally consistent document (RCW 36.70A.070).
- E. The amendment meets the goals, objectives, and policies of the GMACP as discussed in the specific findings.
- F. The amendment to the GMACP satisfies the procedural and substantive requirements of the GMA.
- 26 G. The amendment maintains the GMACP's consistency with the CPPs for Snohomish County.
- 27 H. All SEPA requirements with respect to this non-project action have been satisfied.
- I. The County complied with state and local public participation requirements under the GMA and chapter 30.73 SCC.
- 31 <u>Section 3</u>. The county council bases its findings and conclusions on the entire record of the county council, including all testimony and exhibits. Any finding, which should be deemed a

<u>Section 6.</u> Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the Growth Management Hearings Board, or a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance. Provided, however, that if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid by the Board or court of competent jurisdiction, then the section, sentence, clause or phrase in effect prior to the effective date of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect for that individual section, sentence, clause or phrase as if this ordinance had never been adopted.
