ORDINANCE NO. 09-025

RELATING TO COUNTY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, REVISING
PROVISIONS GOVERNING QUALIFICATIONS OF APPOINTEES,
AND AMENDING SCC 2.03.060

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.03 SCC establishes procedures and criteria that are generally applicable to recommendations and appointments to, and service on, county boards and commissions; and

WHEREAS, additional procedures or criteria can be found in other chapters of the Snohomish County Code, including but not limited to Chapter 4.25 SCC, which creates the Chemical Dependency/Mental Health Program Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, appointments to the Chemical Dependency/Mental Health Program Advisory Board are governed by SCC 4.25.080, which directs that the Board include representatives of the county jail and superior court and of law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, SCC 2.03.060 should be clarified so that the general requirements of Chapter 2.03 SCC relating to eligibility for appointment to county boards and commissions are not applied to supersede more specific requirements contained in other chapters of the county code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.03.060, adopted by Ordinance No. 82-037 on June 9, 1982, is amended to read:

2.03.060 General requirements.


~~((Candidates))~~ Except as otherwise specified by ordinance, candidates for appointment to county boards or commissions must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Possess qualifications for the appointment sought, as shown by the candidate's written documentation and any hearing testimony;
- (2) If a reappointment, demonstrate the continuing benefits of retaining the board member as discussed in the executive's recommendation, and a satisfactory attendance record, as determined by adopted criteria of the particular board;
- (3) Reside or work in Snohomish county, or show evidence of special interest in Snohomish county, PROVIDED That a candidate may not be a county employee;

1 (4) Membership is limited to one position at a time on a board or
2 commission, PROVIDED That a member of a board may simultaneously serve
3 on one ad hoc or advisory committee.
