NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Section 4 of Emergency Ordinance No. 13-016, adopted on February 20, 2013, is amended to read:

Section 4. Sunset. This ordinance is repealed effective ((February 20, 2015, or as otherwise amended by the county council)) October 6, 2014.
