ORDINANCE NO. 18-040

RELATED TO THE 2018 BUDGET;  
MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN GENERAL FUND 002  
TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR BALLOT POSTAGE

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The Snohomish County Council makes the following findings of fact: a supplemental appropriation in General Fund 002, for the 2018 budget year, in the amount of \$166,602, is necessary to provide expenditure authority related to elections ballot postage. The ballot postage will be funded by revenue received from a Washington Secretary of State grant in the amount of \$166,602.

Section 2. The appropriation unit and allocation detail for the supplemental appropriation described in Section 1 are as follows:



Section 4. The County Council further finds that there is a need for such supplemental appropriation authorized by this ordinance because the funds that support it were unanticipated at the time of adoption of the 2018 budget and have not been previously appropriated.




