9 AMENDING CHAPTER 11.50 SCC WHEELED ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES
10 (WATVS) ON CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS OF
11 35 MILES PER HOUR OR LESS

14 WHEREAS, on December 6, 2017, the county council approved Amended
15 Ordinance No. 17-032 creating chapter 11.50 SCC Wheeled All-Terrain Vehicles (WATVs)
16 that applies to the operation of all WATVs on certain county roads with posted speed limits
17 of 35 miles per hour or less; and

19 WHEREAS, the county council held a public hearing on September 26, 2018 to hear
20 public comment on the proposed amendment to chapter 11.50 SCC; and

22 WHEREAS, the county council concludes that chapter 11.50 SCC should be
23 amended as set forth herein.

27 Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 11.50.030, adopted by
28 Amended Ordinance No. 17-032 on December 6, 2017, is amended to read:

30 **11.50.030 Operation on county roads.**

31 (1) All WATVs operating on county roads must:

32 (a) Comply with all Washington State registration requirements in accordance
33 with RCW 46.09.410 and 46.09.420 and WATV use permits in accordance
34 with RCW 46.09.430; and

35 (b) Meet all equipment requirements, be certified by a Washington State
36 licensed wheeled all-terrain vehicle dealer or motor vehicle repair shop, and
37 declaration requirements in accordance with RCW 46.09.457.

38 (2) All persons operating WATVs on county roads must meet all registration
39 and licensing requirements as set forth in chapter [46.09](#) RCW.

40 (3) All persons operating WATVs on county roads are required to carry proof
41 of current liability insurance in compliance with, and with coverage limits at least
42 equivalent to the amounts set forth in chapter [46.29](#) RCW.

43 ~~((3))~~(4) All persons operating WATVs on county roads must obey all traffic
44 laws including but not limited to rules of the road, traffic law or code, parking
45 regulations, and road closures or restrictions, unless otherwise expressly exempted
46 by chapter [46.09](#) RCW. WATV operators must obey posted speed limits while
47 traveling on open county roads.

48 ~~((4))~~(5) Headlights meeting the requirements of RCW [46.37.030](#) and
49 [46.37.040](#) and used at all times when the vehicle is in motion.

1 ((5))(6) Tail lamp meeting the requirements of RCW [46.37.525](#) and used at
 2 all times when the vehicle is in motion.



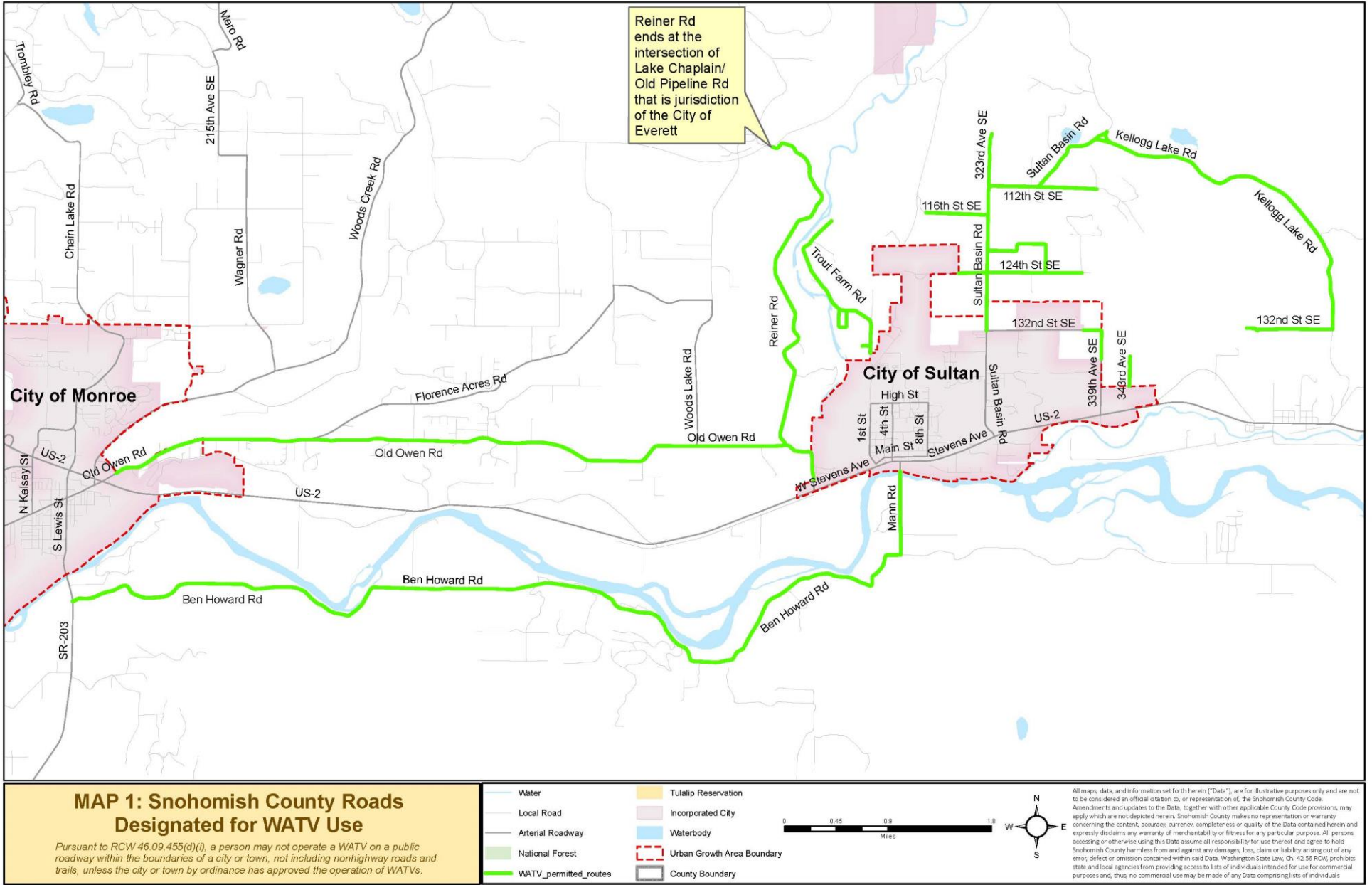
