ORDINANCE NO. 19-032

RELATED TO THE 2019 BUDGET; MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN  
THE BOATING SAFETY FUND 194 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE  
AUTHORITY FOR UNANTICIPATED COSTS IN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: An emergency appropriation in the Boating Safety Fund 194, for the 2019 budget year, in the amount of \$88,000, is necessary to provide expenditure authority to cover unanticipated costs in the Sheriff's Office Marine Unit. The appropriation is needed to replace a boat used by the Marine Unit for its boating safety program.

Section 2. The appropriation unit and allocation detail of the emergency appropriation are as follows:

Section 3. The County Council finds that there is sufficient funding available and there is a need for such emergency appropriation. Replacement of the Marine Unit's boat is necessary to continue providing a boating safety program to the community. The need for this appropriation was not known and could not have been determined prior to the adoption of the 2019 budget. The County Council therefore finds that the need for the appropriation authorized by this ordinance constitutes a public emergency that could not reasonably have been foreseen at the
