12	11-014, on May 25, 2011, is amended to read:

14	9.12.055 Animal relinquishment fee.		
15	(1) Residents of unincorporated Snohomish County may for a fee (($\frac{6f \$25.00}{1}$)) per animal		
16	deliver and relinquish ownership of unwanted dogs or cats owned by them to any animal shelter		
17	providing that service pursuant to a contract with the County. Residents may deliver stray dogs		
18	or cats without payment of a fee to any animal shelter providing that service pursuant to a		
19	contract with the County.

21	(2) The fee shall be paid directly to the animal shelter by the person relinquishing the animal at		
22 23	the time of release.		
23 24	(3) All fees become the property of Snohomish County and shall be transmitted to the county in		
25	the same manner as other fees collected and remitted according to the process specified in the		
26	current shelter services contract.

28	(4) The fee for relinquishment of an animal shall be set by the director of animal services, subject		
29	to approval by the county council by motion.
