ORDINANCE NO. 22-038

RELATED TO THE 2022 BUDGET; MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL  
APPROPRIATION IN GENERAL FUND 002 TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE  
AUTHORITY FOR FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE WASHINGTON STATE  
ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The Snohomish County Council finds as a fact that a supplemental appropriation in General Fund 002, in the 2022 budget year, in the amount of \$300,000, is necessary to provide expenditure authority for funds received from the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts for the reimbursement of court ordered refunds of Legal Financial Obligations ("LFOs") for eligible persons seeking to vacate felony convictions and/or to be re-sentenced pursuant to State v. Blake, 481 P.3d 521 (2021).

Section 2. The appropriation unit and allocation detail for the supplemental appropriation described in Section 1 are as follows:


