ORDINANCE NO. 23-002

RELATING TO THE 2022 BUDGET; MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION IN
FUND 124 TO PROVIDE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR RENTAL ASSISTANCE

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$15,000,000 is necessary in Human Services Fund 124, for budget year 2022, to provide expenditure authority for an unanticipated increase in rental assistance needs.

Section 2. The appropriation unit and allocation detail for the emergency appropriation described in Section 1 are as follows:

Section 3. The County Council further finds that the use of funds is necessary to protect public health in response to an unanticipated increase in rental assistance needs. The need for these expenditures was not known and could not have been determined prior to the adoption of the 2022 budget. The County Council therefore finds that the need for the appropriation authorized by this ordinance constitutes a public emergency that could not have reasonably been foreseen at the time of budget approval and appropriation for the 2022 and hereby authorizes the appropriation.
