## ORDINANCE NO.

ORDINANCE NO. 80-121  
AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE  
SECTIONS 7.41.010, 7.41.050, 7.41.060 & 7.41.070  
AND ALSO TO AMEND SCC SECTION 7.40.040  
TO EXPLICATE THE PROCEDURE BY WHICH THE  
COUNTY COUNCIL WILL APPROVE OPERATING  
RULES PREPARED BY THE DIRECTOR OF  
PUBLIC WORKS

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. That SCC Sections 7.41.010, 7.41.050, 7.41.060 and 7.41.070 as enacted and amended by Resolutions adopted on March 3, 1975, July 21, 1975, December 13, 1976 and June 8, 1977 is repealed, effective upon the date that new "Operating Rules and Disposal Fees for Snohomish County Solid Waste Disposal Sites" become effective (March 9, 1981).

Section 2. Snohomish County Code Section 7.40.040, adopted as a Resolution on August 14, 1972, which now reads as follows:

7.40.040 Operation of solid waste disposal sites by county. The Snohomish County public works department shall be the operating authority for all solid waste disposal sites owned or operated by the county. The director of public works department shall prepare operating rules for such solid waste disposal sites, which rules, upon adoption by the board, shall govern hours of operation, disposal fees charged, acceptable solid waste products, and all matters necessary to assure compliance with federal, state and local regulations applicable to such sites. The county reserves the right to provide in said operating rules that certain solid wastes, based on source, type, or volume, shall not be accepted, or only conditionally accepted, at solid waste disposal sites owned or operated by the county. The operating rules for such sites shall be consistent with this chapter and with regulations promulgated by the board of health pursuant to Section 7.40.070 of this chapter.

is amended to read as follows:

7.40.040 Operation of solid waste disposal sites by county. The Snohomish County public works department shall be the operating authority for all solid waste disposal sites owned or operated by the county. The director of public works department shall prepare operating rules for such solid waste

disposal sites, which rules, upon adoption by the council, shall govern hours of operation, disposal fees charged, acceptable solid waste products, and all matters necessary to assure compliance with federal, state and local regulations applicable to such sites. Adoption by the county council shall be done by resolution, with full final power residing in the council to accept, reject or modify, in whole or in part, the rules prepared by the director of public works. The county reserves the right to provide in said operating rules that certain solid wastes, based on source, type, or volume, shall not be accepted, or only conditionally accepted, at solid waste disposal sites owned or operated by the county. The operating rules for such sites shall be consistent with this chapter and with regulations promulgated by the board of health pursuant to Section 7.40.070 of this chapter.
