ORDINANCE NO. 81-003
RELATING TO MEDICAL-DENTAL COVERAGE
OF COUNTY EMPLOYEES

Be It Resolved:

Section 1. Resolution No. 80-122 adopted April 16, 1980
is repealed.

Section 2. Section 3.24.020 of the Snohomish County
Code as enacted in Resolution No. 79-332, on November 5,
1979, which now reads:

3.24.020 Payments--Termination of agreement. In
adopting this program of group insurance, the board
agrees:

- (1) To pay all or a part of the total premium for each covered employee for group life, accident, hospital and surgical insurance premium for a single employee;
- (2) To make the necessary payroll deduction to cover any portion of the premium not paid by the political subdivision and to maintain membership rolls and related records as may be required by the plan;
- (3) To transmit the total premium payment required under the contract in accordance with the number of

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employees and dependents covered each month to the trustees or to the designated agent or agency;

(4) To make the necessary budgetary provisions for the employer's contribution to the premium and to defray the necessary costs of administration within the political subdivisions;

(5) To participate in the plan on a year-to-year basis. The years shall run from January 1st to December 31st, or until terminated as provided in said trust.

is amended to read:

3.24.020 Payments--Termination of agreement.

(1) To pay all or part of the premiums for group life, medical and dental coverage of an employee covered by a union contract, and/or the spouse and/or dependent children of such employee as required by the employee's current union contract; and to pay all or part of the premiums for group life, medical and dental coverage of an employee not covered by a union contract in amounts equal to the maximum provided in any current union contract with any union employee; Provided, that this section shall create no obligation to make any payment in behalf of a union employee other than required by his current contract or in behalf of any non-union employee upon the amendment or repeal of this section;

(2) Make necessary payroll deductions to cover any portion of premiums not paid by the county as authorized by employees and to maintain membership rolls and related records as required by the plan;

(3) Transmit the total premium payment required under the contract in accordance with the number of employees and dependents covered each month to the trustees or to the designated agent or agency;


(4) Make the necessary budgetary provisions for the employer's contribution to premiums and to defray the necessary costs of administration of the plan; and

(5) Participate in the plan on a year-to-year basis. The years shall run from January 1st to December 31st, or until terminated as provided in said trust.
