ORDINANCE NO. 81- 006  
RELATING TO AND CREATING THE  
POSITION OF COMMISSIONER OF  
SUPERIOR COURT

BE IT ORDAINED: New sections are added to the Snohomish  
County Code as follows:

Chapter 2.14

Superior Court Commissioner

2.14.010 Creation of Position. Pursuant to Chapter 54,  
Laws of 1979, 1st Ex. Sess., there is created within the  
Superior Courts of Snohomish County the position of Court  
Commissioner.

2.14.020 Duties. The duties of the Court Commissioner  
shall primarily include the hearing and/or disposition of  
cases and other matters relating to domestic relations and  
ex parte motions, and shall also include such other duties  
as are assigned by the Superior Court.

2.14.030 Establishment of Salary - Source Priority.  
The salary established herein reflects an annual salary rate  
for 1981 of \$36,207.00. In future years, the annual salary  
for the position of Court Commissioner created by this

ordinance shall be and continue to be in an amount equal to ninety percent (90%) of the annual salary for District Court Judges for Snohomish County.

Funding sources for this position shall be according to the following priority:

(a) Revenues generated by this increase in marriage license fees as authorized by Chapter 124, Laws of 1980, Regular Session;

(b) Revenues generated by the reimbursement to the County for filing fees or such costs as ordered to be paid by parties to paternity orders and responding reciprocal orders under the Uniform Reciprocal Enforcement of Support Act (URESA).
