BE IT ORDAINED:

That there is added to Snohomish County Code a new chapter known as Chapter 21.30, River Improvement Fund Participation to read as follows:

Chapter 21.30

River Improvement Fund Participation

Sections:

21.30.010 Guidelines designated.

21.30.010 Guidelines designated. The following conditions must be met before the emergency project will qualify for river improvement funds:

(1) The erosion must be occurring at an accelerated rate in contrast to the natural wearing of the stream bank. This acceleration may be due to soil characteristics, debris or increased curvilinear flow of the stream.

(2) The endangered property may consist of cultivated, ~~((or))~~ pastured, residential or recreational lands, or as approved by the council.

(3) The proposed emergency action must be consistent with the policy of the act.

The ((county-engineer's)) department of public works will make the initial determination in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Soil Conservation Service, and submit its recommendation for final approval to the county council, which may approve or reject the same.

Job agreement for work approved by the council may be approved by the county executive or his designee.
