ORDINANCE NO. 81-104



PERTAINING TO THE REPEAL OF CIVIL PENALTIES OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY
CODE AS CONTAINED in 16.20.010 - 16.20.040 AND THE ENACTMENT OF
CIVIL AND CRIMINAL PENALTIES OF
SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE
AS CONTAINED
IN 16.20.005 - 16.20.020.

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Chapter 16.20 as adopted January 15, 1979, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The following is adopted and made a part of the Snohomish County Code:

16.20.005 Chapter 17.40 Adopted by Reference

The Civil Penalty for violation of the Snohomish County Building Code as contained in Chapter 17.40 to the exclusion of 17.40.005 and .010 of the Snohomish County Code, is adopted by reference as if fully set out herein, except that the words "Uniform Fire Code, 1979 Edition" are substituted for "Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition".

16.20.010 Cumulative Civil Penalty

In addition to or as an alternative to any other penalty provided herein or by law, any person, firm or corporation which violates the provisions of the title, or violates the provisions of the Uniform Codes as adopted by reference by said title, shall incur a cumulative civil penalty in the amount of fifty (\$50.00) dollars per day from the date set for correction pursuant to Section 17.40.020 until the violation is corrected.

16.20.020 Criminal Penalty

In addition to, or as an alternative to any cumulative civil penalty as provided in Section 16.20.010, a criminal penalty may be imposed by

a Court of competent jurisdiction for any of the following violations:

Failure to obey lawful order of Fire Official. 2.107 UFC, 3.101 UFC

Destruction of posted service orders, tags, notices. 3.104 UFC, 13,105

Obstructing fire personnel or equipment at or enroute to a reported emergency 10.102

Tampering with: Fire equipment 10.201
Fire hydrant 10.202
Barricade 10.204

Kindled, maintained, or authorized a fire without a permit. 11.101

Failed to have competent attendant at fire until fire is extinguished. 11.101C ✓

Transmitted false alarm. 11.302

Failure to secure vacant building. 11.413, 11.414

Failure to obey regulations prohibiting smoking. 13.101

Failure to maintain required first aid fire appliances. 10.301, 10.302

Failure to maintain required exitways. 25.108

Allow the continued and uncorrected overcrowding of a building. 25.113C

Failure to notify appropriate agency of: fumigation (toxic & flammable) 47.104
building move 101.100 SCC

Parking: hydrant 10.202
tank vehicles (hazardous cargo, cryogenic, flammable liquid & gas) 79.1106

Failure to properly placard hazardous chemicals and flammables. 80.111
