ORDINANCE NO. 81-105

PERTAINING TO THE AMENDMENT OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY BUILDING CODE (UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1979 EDITION AND AMENDMENTS) AS CONTAINED IN 17.04.010 - 17.04.330 OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE BY THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 17.04.190 (SECTION 3.07 OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1979 EDITION)

Section 1. Section 17.04.190 adopted by Ordinance 81-011 which reads as follows:

17.04.190 Section 307 amended--Occupancy. Section 307(a) is amended to read:

Use or Occupancy. No building or structure in Groups A, E, I, H, B, or R, Division 1 Occupancy, shall be used or occupied, and no change in the existing occupancy classification of a building or structure or portion thereof shall be made until the Building Official has issued a Certificate of Occupancy therefor as provided herein. No building in Group R-3 or M shall be used or occupied without first having obtained final inspection and approval by the Building Official or his authorized representative. (Ord. adopted March 9, 1981).

Is amended to read as follows:

Section 17.04.190 Section 307 amended--occupancy. Section 307(a) is amended to read:

No building, structure or portion thereof in Group A, E, I, H, B or R Division 1 occupancy shall be used or occupied, and no change in use occupancy classification of a building, structure or portion thereof, shall be made until the Building Official has issued a Certificate of Occupancy for such uses, or change of uses as each occurs, or at least annually, PROVIDED, that such Certificate of Occupancy shall not issue until the requirements of Chapter 16.04, Snohomish County Code, have been met. The Inspection and Compliance Division of Community Development shall inspect said occupancy uses as necessary, but at least annually, prior to the reissuance of a Certificate of Occupancy as required herein.
