ORDINANCE NO. 82-022  
RELATING TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY  
EQUIPMENT RENTAL AND  
REVOLVING FUND

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Section 4.34.070 of the Snohomish County Code enacted January 11, 1978, is repealed.

Section 2. A new section 4.34.075 reading as follows is added to the Snohomish County Code:

4.34.075 Transfers, Replacement of equipment. As of January 11, 1978, funds and equipment in accordance with the following table were transferred to the fund:

Funds for department reserves for the replacement of equipment have been collected and shall be continued to be collected by the director of public works in accord with this chapter. Any funds contributed to such reserve by a department may be used to replace any equipment of such department. Upon request of the director of any department and/or the determination of the director of public works to replace any worn out or obsolete piece or pieces of equipment for his department, the director of public works shall replace such equipment from the using department's share of the reserve fund; provided, that during any current year expenditures from the reserve for replacement of equipment by any department shall not reduce the department's reserve balance to less than 15 percent of the replacement value of the equipment fleet of such department determined as follows:

Not later than July 31 of the year preceding the next budget year, the director of public works shall determine the value of each department's equipment fleet as of January 1 of the involved year calculated upon the original purchase price of equipment in such fleet. Where an original

purchase price is not available, the estimate of the director of public works of the original purchase price shall be used.

In an emergency if the requirements of a department for needed replacement of its equipment cannot be satisfied from the amount available from the reserve as calculated above, the director of the department or the director of public works, with the approval of the county executive, may apply to the county council for authority to expend additional funds from the department's reserve for the replacement of equipment. Replacement of any equipment may be paid in full or part from available sources other than the reserve.

If any deficit should result in any departments' equipment account, said deficit shall be added to the 15% minimum balance requirement.

Upon the purchase of any replacement equipment, the director of public works shall determine the rental to be charged for such equipment to meet the needs stated in Section 4.34.040 and immediately charge and collect such rental from the renting department. Such rental rates shall be subject to not less than an annual review provided in Section 4.34.040.

Section 3. Section 4.34.080, reading as follows, is added to the Snohomish County Code:

4.34.080. Deposits in fund. The County Council may, from time to time, place moneys in the fund from any source lawfully available to it and may transfer equipment, materials and supplies of any office or department to the equipment rental and revolving fund with or without charge consistent with RCW 43.09.210. Charges for the rental of equipment and for providing materials, supplies, and services to any county office or department shall be paid monthly into the fund. Proceeds received from other governmental agencies for similar charges and from the sale of equipment or other personal property owned by the equipment rental and revolving fund, which is no longer of any value to or needed by the county, shall be placed in the fund as received.
