ORDINANCE NO. 82-023

RELATING TO DISCLOSURE OF FINANCIAL INTEREST OF PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES, ADOPTION OF DEPARTMENTAL CODE OF ETHICS AND AMENDING SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 2.50

BE IT ORDAINED:

a) That Snohomish County Code Section 2.50.030 enacted on December 17, 1980 as Ordinance No. 80-093 is amended to read as follows:

2.50.030 Disclosure on actions. No public official shall knowingly engage in any action which will directly affect Snohomish County, and which is not ministerial, including communications, discussions, persuading or participating in decisions or determinations with respect to county matters, without fully disclosing the following:

- (1) That campaign contributions, gratuity or personal expenses of the public official in excess of ((one-hundred dollars)) five hundred dollars (\$500.00) have been made to the official by any person or entity of any sort which is specifically involved in the action;
((b))(2) That any members of the public official's immediate family has any direct financial interest in the action.

b) That Snohomish County Code Section 2.50.070 is amended to read as follows:

2.50.070 Departmental Code of Ethics. The Council, the executive (( - )) and the head of each administrative or executive department, with the approval of the executive and the appropriate ((each)) elected executive officer, shall adopt a code of ethics applicable to the ((to control the conduct of)) officials and employees under his, her or its control which shall contain all the provisions and requirements of this chapter together with such additional provisions as shall be deemed necessary by the elected official or department head.
