ORDINANCE NO. 82-057  
RELATING TO SUPERIOR COURT JURORS' FEES  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. A new section is added to the Snohomish  
County Code as follows:

Chapter 4.06

Jury Fees

4.06.020 Out of County Fees. Any juror who is called  
on a criminal superior court case to be heard by a jury  
composed of people who are not residents of Snohomish County  
as provided by RCW 10.25.140 shall be paid the same fees as  
are authorized by the county of residence of such juror.  
The fees to be paid to such juror shall be certified by the  
superior court judge hearing the case for which such jury is  
called.

Section 2. The council finds as a fact that this  
ordinance is necessary to avoid inequities which would  
result if non-resident jurors were paid less than the fees  
of their county of residence, that an emergency exists, and  
that this ordinance is necessary for the support of county  
government and its existing public institutions.
