SNOHOMISH COUNTY SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Section 1 repeals Snohomish County Code Chapter 7.34
(Solid Waste Advisory Committee) as enacted on October 9,
1978.

Section 2 adopts a new Chapter 7.34 (Solid Waste
Advisory Committee) concerning the composition and duties of
the Snohomish County Solid Waste Advisory Committee, as
follows:

CHAPTER 7.34

SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

7.34.010 Committee Formed; Name. The Snohomish County
Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC) is hereby established,
to be comprised of a county-wide group of representatives of
municipalities, citizens and industry, to provide for
coordination and information exchange between
municipalities, citizens and industry.

7.34.020 Membership; Term of Office. Membership of the
Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall be as follows:

(1) Regular Members. Membership of the Solid Waste
Advisory Committee shall be filled by the Snohomish County
Council with individuals recommended by the Executive who
represent the following jurisdictions and areas of interest:

- City of Everett
- City of Lynnwood
- City of Mountlake Terrace
- City of Edmonds
- Snohomish County Public Utility District No. 1
- Two representatives from other cities and

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towns in the county

Three representatives at large from
unincorporated Snohomish County

Two representatives from solid waste industry
and recyclers

Two representatives from industry in general

One representative from the Health District

One ex officio representative from the
Department of Ecology

(2) Auxiliary Members. The regular membership of the Solid Waste Advisory Committee may appoint auxiliary members for a specific time period to serve on the Committee in a non-voting capacity, for the purpose of providing specific information, technical advice, information of a general nature which is pertinent to the Committee's activities or any other form of assistance which will aid the Committee in carrying out its purposes.

(3) Term of Office. Terms of office for regular members shall be for a two-year period from the date of appointment, whether the member is appointed at the commencement of an initial term or at a point thereafter.

7.34.030 Chairman. The Committee shall be chaired by a chairman, assisted by a vice chairman; both shall be elected by the Committee from within the Committee membership and shall serve for a period of one year.

7.34.040 Role of the Committee. The Committee shall:

1. Coordinate information exchange on solid waste and resource recovery issues between Snohomish County and the municipalities, citizens and industries of Snohomish County.

2. Provide policy recommendations to Snohomish County on solid waste and resource recovery issues which reflect both the needs and most appropriate use of resources of the citizens of Snohomish County that meet the requirements for safe, cost effective and environmentally acceptable solid waste disposal and recovery.

3. Review and provide comments on plans prepared by the Solid Waste Division of the Executive Branch for implementing features of the solid waste management program, including disposal and recovery options.

4. The Committee will adopt and submit to Snohomish County for review the following:

Annual goals and objectives

Annual progress report

7.34.050 Meetings. The Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall meet as required to carry out the purposes of the Committee. Meetings may be held at various locations within the County with written notification to the membership and chairman designating the time and place of such meetings. Meetings shall be held not less than quarterly. A quorum

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shall consist of seven members in attendance. A majority of voting members will pass a motion.

7.34.060 Minutes and Staff Support. The Snohomish County Department of Public Works shall provide a recording secretary and staff support, as necessary, for the meetings of the Committee.
