An Ordinance amending Chapter 6.19 of Snohomish County Code Pawnbrokers and Secondhand Dealers, requiring written parental permission to be on file with Sheriff before goods can be received from any person under eighteen years of age.

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 6.19.080 of the Snohomish County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~6.19.080 Receiving goods from certain people unlawful.~~

(1) It is unlawful for any pawnbroker or secondhand dealer, his clerk or employee, to receive in pledge or purchase, any article or thing from any person under eighteen years of age, or from any person who is at the time intoxicated from the use of alcohol or other drugs or from any person who is known to be a thief, or a receiver of stolen property, or from any person whom he has reason to suspect or believe to be such.
