ORDINANCE 83-060

AMENDMENTS TO SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE,
TITLE 18, PERTAINING TO THE USE OF
SHORELINE STABILIZATION MEASURES

BE IT ORDAINED:

New Section, Section 1: A new section is added to Snohomish County Code, Title 18, as follows:

18.08.562 Shoreline Stabilization Structures and Practices. "Shoreline stabilization structures and practices" means any structural or non-structural method of preventing streambank erosion for the purpose of minimizing downstream sedimentation and/or protecting adjacent property from damage.

New Section, Section 2: A new section is added to Snohomish County Code, Title 18, as follows:

18.18.020(21) Shoreline stabilization structures and practices, provided that all structures and practices shall conform to the requirements of SCC 21 and the Shoreline Management Master Program as applicable.

New Section, Section 3: A new section is added to Snohomish County Code, Title 18, as follows:

18.66.020(14) Shoreline stabilization structures and practices, provided that all structures and practices shall conform to the requirements of SCC 21 and the Shoreline Management Master Program as applicable.

Section 4: That Snohomish County Code Section 18.68.040(8), last amended on August 20, 1981 as Ordinance No. 81-079, is amended to read as follows:

18.68.040(8) Water-dependent utilities and other installations which by their very nature must be in the floodway. Examples of such uses are: dams for domestic/industrial water supply, flood control and/or hydroelectric production; water diversion structures and facilities for water supply, irrigation and/or fisheries enhancement; flood water and drainage pumping plants and facilities; hydroelectric generating facilities and appurtenant structures; ((and)) structural and non-structural flood damage reduction facilities; and shoreline stabilization structures and practices. PROVIDED, that the applicant shall supply convincing evidence that a floodway location is necessary in view of the objectives of the proposal and provided further that the proposal is consistent with other provisions of the flood hazard zone and the shoreline management master program. In meeting these tests, projects designed to divert water for beneficial public and/or environmental reasons shall not be prohibited on the basis of 18.68.040 B.2. as that provision pertains to the material diversion of water. In all instances of locating utilities and other installations in

floodway locations, project design must incorporate floodproofing. (Section 1 of Ordinance 81-079 adopted August 20, 1981; Section 1 of Ordinance 81-059 adopted June 23, 1981.)

New Section, Section 5: A new section is added to Snohomish County Code, Title 18, as follows:

18.70.030(4) Shoreline stabilization structures and practices, provided that all structures and practices shall conform to the requirements of SCC 21 and the Shoreline Management Master Program as applicable.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect on _____, 1983.
