PROHIBITING THE USE OF INTERNAL COMBUSTION MOTORS ON LAKE CONNOR

Snohomish County Code, Title 12, Chapter 12.08, Use Intensity Classifications for Specified lakes, subsection 12.08.030, "Motorboats - Internal combustion motors prohibited", adopted by resolution June 30, 1975, is amended to read.

12.08.030 Motorboats--Internal combustion motors prohibited: Due to the inadequate flow or other factors where pollution from motor discharge is aggravated by internal combustion motor discharge, or the pristine character of upland lakes over one thousand five hundred feet in elevation in danger of being seriously damaged, or the small size (under forty-five acres), or shallow depth, or a configuration rendering the use of internal combustion motor-powered watercraft hazardous, the propulsion of a motorboat in whole or in part by an internal combustion motor is unlawful upon the following lakes:




