

ORDINANCE NO. 85-032





PARK AND RECREATION

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1: Snohomish County Code, Chapter 2.16 - Park and Recreation, and the following resolutions, are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance:

- Section 1 of Resolution adopted March 4, 1963;
- (b) Resolution adopted June 13, 1966;
- Sections 2 and 3 of Resolution adopted February 4, (c) 1975;
- (d) Sections 2 and 3 of Resolution adopted February 10, 1975;
- Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Resolution adopted March 3, 1975; (e)
- Sections 1, 2 and 3 of Resolution adopted May 28, (f) 1975;
- (q) Resolution adopted June 24, 1976.

New Section Section 2: The following chapters are hereby adopted as part of the Snohomish County Code:

- 2.16.010 Park and Recreation Division Established. The Park and Recreation Division of Snohomish County is hereby established as a division of the Department of Community and Educational Services.
- 2.16.020 Park and Recreation Division Duties. duties of the Park & Recreation Division shall be to:
- Establish the parks and recreation system for Snohomish County.
- (2) Administer and supervise the maintenance and operation of county parks.
 - (3) Develop annual Park and Recreation Division budget.
- (4) Develop Park and Recreation Division capital improvement program.
 - Plan and develop master plan for county parks.
 - Develop Park and Recreation Comprehensive Plan.
- (7) Make recommendations to the Director of Community and Educational Services as to the establishment of rules and regulations regarding county park usage and fee schedules for county parks.
- (8) Perform such other duties as determined by the Director.
- 2.16.030 Park Advisory Board Established. There is hereby established a Snohomish County Park Advisory Board,

hereinafter referred to as "Advisory Board", to assist the Director of Community and Educational Services and the Parks Manager in reviewing and recommending policies relating to parks, playgrounds or other recreational facilities.

2.16.040 - Membership of the Board. The Advisory Board shall be composed of eleven (11) members. Five (5) members shall represent and be appointed from the council districts and shall reside in the council district from which they are appointed. Six (6) members shall serve at-large and may reside anywhere within the county.

Appointments and terms shall be pursuant to Ch 2.03 SCC. The Advisory Board shall be representative of a broad range of interest.

2.16.050 - Terms of Members. Subject to other provisions in this section, terms of the Board members shall be for four (4) years. Terms of those members representing council districts shall initially expire on January 15, 1987. Terms of those members serving at-large shall initially expire on January 15, 1989.

2.16.060 - Compensation. The Advisory Board members shall be reimbursed for mileage to and from meetings, and for other expenses as approved by the Executive, as limited by budgetary constraints.

2.16.070 - Meeting and Election of Officers. The Advisory Board shall meet at least monthly, act under Robert's Rules of Order, adopt by-laws and elect its chairman, vice chairman and secretary from within the Board membership.

2.16.080 - Vacancies. A position shall become vacant upon expiration of the term. A position shall become vacant within the period of term upon the death, resignation, removal, or change of residence outside the geographic area of appointment, if any, of a member of the Advisory Board. Any vacancies shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as the appointment of the preceeding member, and any appointee to fill a vacancy, other than for expiration of term, shall serve only for the balance of the full term of his predecessor.

2.16.090 - Removal. Any member of the Advisory Board may be removed by the Council for neglect of duty or malfeasance in office, and pursuant to general removal provisions enacted for county boards and commissions.

2.16.100 - Duties of the Advisory Board. The Advisory Board shall provide, advise, consult, and assist the Director of Community and Educational Services and the Parks Manager in recommending to the Executive and Council, actions on the following:

- Master plan for county parks;
- Park and Recreation Comprehensive Plan;
- Capitol improvement programs;
- Annual budgets;
- Rate schedules;
- Rules and Regulations; and
- Other matters as requested.
