ORDINANCE NO. 85-116

PROVIDING A COMPENSATION PLAN FOR CERTAIN SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES; AMENDING CHAPTER 3a.13 SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

WHEREAS, all persons regularly employed in the Snohomish County Sheriff's Department are subject to the rules and regulations of Chapter 41.14 Revised Code of Washington, Civil Service for Sheriff's Office and are, in some regards, exempt from Chapter 31.13 SCC; and

WHEREAS, with regard to the subject of compensation, most employees of the Sheriff's Department belong to either a collective bargaining unit (union) or are provided for under Chapter 3.68 Snohomish County Code, the Exempt Personnel Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, some employees of the Sheriff's Department are excluded from the collective bargaining unit due to the supervisory and/or confidential characteristics of their positions; are not provided for under the terms of Chapter 3.68 SCC; and, are also excluded from the county's personnel rules pursuant to Chapter 3a.13 SCC; and,

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that those certain employees of the Snohomish County Sheriff's Department should be protected by some form of compensation plan;

Ordinance Providing Compensation Plan for Certain Sheriff's Department Employees - 1 s:ord85-116:115 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED;

Section 1. The following new section is added to Chapter 3a.13 of the Snohomish County Code:

3a.13.040 Compensation Plan for Certain Sheriff's

Department Employees. (1) Other provisions of Chapter

3a.13 SCC notwithstanding, the following positions/employees
within the Snohomish County Sheriff's Department shall not
be exempted from the personnel rules of the county which
relate to salary, wages and benefits, in particular,

Chapters 3a.05 and 3a.06, SCC:

- a) Animal Control Supervisor;
- b) Captain;
- c) Community Assistance Information Manager;
- d) Community Assistance Information Officer;
- e) Fiscal Manager;
- f) Staff Services Manager.
- (2) Where any provision of this section conflicts with the provisions of Chapter 41.14 RCW, Civil Service for Sheriff's Office, or other state law, such state law shall control.

Section 2. Section 3a.13.020 SCC adopted November 21, 1984. is amended as follows:

<u>3a.13.010</u> Exemptions - County Charter. The following positions and employees are exempted from coverage under

Ordinance Providing Compensation Plan for Certain Sheriff's Department Employees - 2 s:ord85-116:115 these rules in accordance with section 7.20 of the county charter:

- (1) All county elected officials;
- (2) Four (4) employees in the county Executive's office as designated by the county Executive;
- (3) Not more than two (2) employees in each other elected official's office as designated by each elected official;
- (4) The head of each executive and administrative department as designated by ordinance;
- (5) The members of all boards and commissions appointed by the County Council or county Executive;
- (6) Those employees in the prosecuting attorney's and sheriff's offices to the extent that the provisions of this chapter have been preempted by ((designated-as-exempt according-to)) state law.
- (7) All persons employed on an independent contractual basis:
- (8) Such other employees as may be designated as exempt by ordinance; and
- (9) All persons exempt under the provisions of any applicable state law.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of January 1, 1986.
