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ORDINANCE NO. 86-006
RELATING TO
MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMS

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. That Chapter 7.48 of the Snohomish County Code, as last amended by Resolution adopted on March 6, 1972, is amended in each of its sections as follows:

MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM

7.48.010 Program created--Services. That a community mental health program is hereby created and established to coordinate and develop one or more of the following services:

- (1) Outpatient diagnostic and treatment services;
- (2) Inpatient psychiatric services;
- (3) Rehabilitation services for patients with psychiatric illnesses;
- (4) Informational services to the general public and educational services furnished by qualified mental health personnel to schools, courts, health agencies, welfare agencies, probation departments and other appropriate public or private agencies or groups;
- (5) Consultant services to public or private agencies for the promotion and coordination of services that preserve mental health and

for the early recognition and management of conditions that might develop into psychiatric illnesses((-i)).

((6)--Coordination-relating-to-alcohol-and-drug-programs-within the-county-which-are-funded-with-earmarked-funds-by-the-Washington State-Department-of-Social-and-Health-Services-through-involvement-of the-community-mental-health-program-administrative-board-))

7.48.020 Board created--Duties. A community mental health program ((administrative)) advisory board is hereby created and established to:

(1) Review and evaluate the mental health needs, services, facilities and special problems of the area((-including-alcoholism and-drug-abuse-)) to be served by the community mental health program;

(2) Advise the county ((commissioners)) council through the county executive as to a program of community mental health services, which program shall reflect the fullest feasible utilization of already existing services((-and-when-appropriate-advise-the-county commissioners-concerning-the-appointment-of-an-executive director/supervisor-of-community-mental-health-services-))

(3)--Receive-and-review-all-applications-for-financial-support under-the-provisions-of-this-act-or-subsequent-acts-relating-to alcoholism-and-drug-abuse-submitted-by-a-nonprofit-corporation, local health-department, or-executive-director/supervisor-of-community mental-health-services-and-submit-recommendations-concerning-these applications-to-the-board-or-boards-of-county-commissioners-))

(4) After county council adoption of a program recommended under the terms of this ((resolution, supervise)) chapter, monitor the financial and service components of the program through ((the executive-director/supervisor-of-community-mental-health-services)) the department of human services in order to be assured that actual expenditures and programs remain consistent with the agreements contained in the ((application)) plan as provided;

(5) ((Submit)) Review annually ((to-the-county-commissioners)) a report of the activities of the community mental health program, including a financial accounting of expenditures;

(6) Submit ((annually)) to the county ((commissioners)) council through the County Executive for approval, a plan of proposed expenditures in accordance with the administrative guidelines of the department of social and health services.

7.48.030 Membership. The community mental health program ((administrative)) advisory board shall consist of not less than nine (9) nor more than fifteen (15) persons recommended by the county executive and appointed by the ((board-of)) county council ((commissioners)). Membership of the board shall be representative of the community and shall include consumer and minority group representation. No more than four elected or appointed city ((or

county)) officials may serve on such administrative board at the same time.

7.48.040 Terms--Compensation. Members of the community mental health program administrative board shall serve terms of three (3) years and until a successor is appointed and qualified. No compensation shall be paid to said members, however subsistence rates and mileage in the amount prescribed by RCW 36.17.030 as now or hereafter amended may be paid for expenses incurred as a result of participation in official meetings of the ((administrative)) advisory board.

7.48.050 Direct service--Administration(--Supervisor). After receipt of recommendations from the community mental health program ((administrative)) advisory board to the ((board-of)) county council ((commissioners)), and approval thereof, the appropriate services shall be provided by the ((board-of-county-commissioners)) department of human services either directly or by contract with nonprofit corporation or corporations ((or-through-the-local-health department)). These services shall be administered subject to and in compliance with RCW ((7-48)) 71.24 ((y-by-an-executive director/supervisor-of-community-mental-health-services-appointed-by the-board-of-county-commissioners-with-the-appointment-subject-to-the approval-of-the-community-mental-health-program-administrative-board. The-executive-director/supervisor-need-not-be-a-resident-of-the county-)) by the department of human services.

7.48.060 ((Supervisor's)) Administrative powers and duties. The executive director/supervisor of Community Mental Health services shall have the following powers and duties:

(1) ((He-shall-s)) Serve as ((chief-executive)) administrative officer of the community mental health program.

(2) ((He-shall-e)) Exercise general supervision over mental health((los;- , alcoholism, or drug abuse)) services furnished, operated, or supported.

(3) ((He-shall-r)) Recommend to the community mental health program ((administrative)) advisory board the provision of services, establishment of facilities, contracts for services or facilities, and other matters necessary or desirable to accomplish the purposes of this act.

(4) ((He-shall-s)) Submit an annual report to the community mental health program ((administrative)) advisory board reporting all activities of the community mental health program, including a financial accounting of expenditures and a proposed budget of anticipated expenditures for the ensuing year.

(5) ((He-may-e)) Carry on such studies as are appropriate for the discharge of his duties.

7.48.070 Contracts. The (~~board-of-county-commissioners~~) department of human services may, upon approval by the county council, contract for services and facilities with any hospital, clinic, laboratory or other similar institution, or with a nonprofit corporation or corporations.

7.48.080 Plan for expenditures--program plans. The (~~board-of-county-commissioners~~) department of human services shall submit annually, to the Secretary of the Washington State Department of Social and Health services, a plan for proposed expenditures, as approved by the county council, in compliance with rules and regulations by the Department and RCW ((7-48) 71.24, or subsequent revisions thereto. (~~program-plans-will-also-be-submitted-to-the Secretary-of-said-Department-for-prior-approval-before-any-plan-or request-is-submitted-by-the-county-to-any-federal-agency-for-federal funds-for-the-support-of-any-aspect-of-the-community-mental-health program-])~~)

7.48.090 Expenditures subject to state law. Expenditures of county funds for the community mental health program shall be subject to the provisions of RCW 36.40 and other statutes relating to expenditures by counties.

7.48.100 Payment for services. Patients receiving services under the community mental health program shall make payments for services in accordance with their ability to pay, but in no event in excess of actual cost. (~~The-board-of-county-commissioners-shall submit-a-plan-to-the-Secretary-of-the-Washington-State-Department-of Social-and-Health-services-relating-the-formula-in-use-for-said payments-)~~)

7.48.110 Gifts--Grants. Any gifts or grants, whether from private, county, state or federal sources, for the community mental health program, shall be accepted and expended only by (~~the-board-of-county-commissioners~~) the department of human services upon approval by the county council.

7.48.((120)) 900 Severability. If any section, sentence or phrase of this (~~resolution~~) chapter is for any reason held to be invalid, then the parts of the (~~resolution~~) chapter not declared to be invalid shall remain in force and effect.


7.48.((130)) 900 Effective date. This (~~resolution~~) chapter shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after the 6th day of March, 1972.


