AMENDING CHAPTER SCC 2.410  
EXPANDING MEMBERSHIP OF CHILDREN'S COMMISSION

Section 1. Snohomish County Code 2.410.010, adopted by Ordinance 85-060 on July 10, 1985, is amended to read:

2.410.010 Children's Commission created. The County Council does hereby create a Children's Commission consisting of ~~((fifteen))~~ twenty-five members which shall serve as advisors on issues of health, safety, and social services for infants, young children and youth in the community. The Commission shall advise the Executive and Department of Human Services on all matters related to the Administration and enhancement of children's programs.

Section 2. Snohomish County Code 2.410.030, adopted by Ordinance 85-060 on July 10, 1985, is amended to read:

2.410.030 Appointment to the Children's Commission. The commission shall be composed of no more than ~~((fifteen))~~ twenty-five members. Appointments shall be made by geographical distribution with ~~((five))~~ ten at-large members from anywhere within the County, and ~~((two))~~ three representing each Council District. Appointments shall be made pursuant to chapter 2.03 SCC. The membership shall represent one or more of the following areas:

- (1) Health and Human Services
- (2) Education
- (3) Business and Labor
- (4) Law and Justice
- (5) ~~((Consumers-and))~~ Concerned citizens
- (6) State Department of Social and Health Services and/or the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
- (7) Children
- (8) Elected Officials
- (9) Minorities
