AUTHORIZING PER DIEM ALLOWANCE FOR COUNCIL LOBBYIST

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1: A new section is added to Snohomish County Code Ch. 3.36 as follows:

3.36.050 Lobbyist per diem allowance. In lieu of the reimbursement for travel expenses provided by any other section of this chapter, any employee of the County, when assigned to a session of the Washington State Legislature as a full-time "lobbyist" as defined in RCW 42.17.020(19), shall receive a per diem allowance for each and every day of the legislative session at a rate equivalent to that authorized by the State Director of Financial Management pursuant to RCW 43.03.050 for members of the Washington State Legislature.

Section 2: That the Council finds as a fact, and states that this ordinance is necessary because of the critical issues affecting Snohomish County that have developed after adoption of the 1987 budget, in particular, legislative proposals relative to sales tax distribution, transportation and human services funding, Navy homeporting and water quality programs and therefore that it is necessary for the support of county government and its existing institutions. Based on the foregoing, the council finds that an emergency exists and that this ordinance shall be effective immediately.
