CREATING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY  
SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM AND ADVISORY BOARD

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. A new chapter 7.58 is hereby created in the Snohomish County Code providing for a Substance Abuse Program and Advisory Board.

Section 2. New sections of the Snohomish County Code, Chapter 7.58 are adopted as follows:

Chapter 7.58

SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAMS

7.58.010--Program created--services. There is hereby created and approved a program known as the Substance Abuse Program directed toward the rehabilitation, treatment and education of persons relating to the use of and suffering from narcotic drugs, dangerous drugs, and alcohol, through the coordination and development of those programs authorized by Chapters 69.54 and 79.96 RCW. These board functions are to be distinguished from those performed by the existing Alcoholism Administration Board as established by Chapter 2.80 SCC.

7.58.020--Board created--duties. A Substance Abuse Advisory Board is hereby created and established to advise the County Executive through the Snohomish County Department of Human Services on all matters relating to funding and development of Drug Treatment and Early Intervention and

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Prevention of Substance Abuse programs. The Substance Abuse Advisory Board's duties follows:

(1) Conduct public hearings and other investigations to determine the needs and priorities for Substance Abuse Treatment, Prevention, Information/Referral Services, Outreach and related services for the citizens of Snohomish County;

(2) Review and recommend for approval plans, policies, budgets, and funding applications;

(3) Evaluate the performance of programs under contract annually through on-site visits and monitoring information provided by county staff;

(4) Advise the County Council through the Department of Human Services on matters relating to the priorities, objectives and tasks to be performed by the department;

(5) Submit to the County Executive names of nominees for appointment to the Substance Abuse Advisory Board.

~~7.58.030--Membership and qualifications.~~ The Substance Abuse Advisory Board shall consist of twelve (12) members recommended by the County Executive and appointed by the County Council in accordance with Chapter 2.03 SCC. The membership shall include a community representative from each County Council district. Members of the board shall be representative of the community and shall include, where possible, former clients, relatives of clients, and members of minority groups, other special groups of local significance including one non-voting liaison from the county Alcoholism Administrative Board. No more than four elected or appointed officials may serve on the Board at any one time. Employees or board members of agencies receiving funding from Snohomish County are ineligible to serve on the County Substance Abuse Advisory Board.

~~7.58.040--Term--compensation.~~ Substance Abuse Advisory Board members shall serve three (3) year terms and until their successors are appointed and qualified, not to exceed two (2) consecutive terms. Initially appointed members may serve shorter terms so that an equal number of vacancies occur each year. No compensation shall be paid to said members, however, subsistence rates and mileage in the amount prescribed by RCW 36.17.030 as now or hereafter amended may be paid for expenses incurred as a result of participation in official meetings of the advisory board.

~~7,58,900--Severability.~~ If any section, sentence or phrase of this chapter is for any reason held to be invalid, then the parts thereof not declared to be invalid shall remain in force and effect.




