ORDINANCE NO. 87-048
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO
COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO
ESTABLISH PARK FEES

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 83-038 as enacted on May 2, 1983 and Snohomish County Code Section 22.12.100 as last amended on April 27, 1983 by Ordinance No. 83-034 are repealed.

Section 2. Snohomish County Code Section 22.04.050 enacted April 27, 1983 as Ordinance No. 83-034 is amended to read as follows:

22.04.050 Fees and Rental Charges.

~~((Reasonable-fees-and-rental-charges-as-set forth-from-time-to-time-by-ordinance-of-the Snohemish-County-Council-will-be-charged-to-offset part-of-the-costs-incurred-by-the-county-in administering-various-recreational-activities-and operating-recreational-facilities-located-at-county parks-))~~

(1) The county executive is authorized to establish an annual fee schedule for park activities including but not limited to camping fees, picnic shelter reservation fees, and fees for use of recreational facilities.

(2) The amount of all fees shall be based upon an estimate of costs incurred by the county in maintaining facilities and services for each activity.

(3) The fee schedule shall be reviewed annually by the parks and recreation division who shall recommend a proposed fee schedule to the park and recreation advisory board.

(4) At a public meeting the park and recreation advisory board shall consider the proposed fee schedule recommended by the parks and recreation division and shall advise the division of the board's concurrence in the proposed fee schedule or suggest modification.

(5) After considering the park and recreation advisory board's recommendations, the parks and recreation division may modify the proposed fee schedule. The parks and recreation division shall then forward its proposed fee schedule to the director of administrative and recreational services.

(6) The director of administrative and recreational services shall either return the proposed fee schedule to parks and recreation division for modification or recommend it for approval to the county executive.

(7) When the county executive approves a proposed fee schedule as recommended by the director of administrative and recreational services, the executive shall issue an order establishing that schedule for a period of one year.

Section 3. The following schedule of fees and rentals shall be in effect as an interim measure, until the county executive approves a new fee schedule but in no case beyond January 1, 1988, and the parks and recreation division is hereby authorized to charge and collect said fees and rentals:
