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EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 87- 122
COOPERATIVE BANK STABILIZATION PROJECTS;
AMENDING SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 21.30

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code section 21.30.050, adopted by Ordinance 87-065 on August 12, 1987, is hereby repealed.

NEW SECTION, Section 2. A new section 21.30.050 is added to Snohomish County Code Chapter 21.30 as follows:

21.30.050 Cooperative Bank Stabilization Projects--County Participation. County participation in cooperative bank stabilization projects shall consist of providing financial assistance to project applicants for the purchase of materials to be utilized in their projects.

(a) For projects for which application for financial assistance is made on or after August 12, 1987, the following procedures shall apply: The amount of financial assistance shall be based upon an estimate (prepared in advance of the work) of the cost of required materials. The department of public works shall review materials estimates in order to assure that they are based upon competitive unit prices. Following approval of the project by the council, the project applicant may proceed with the work. The project applicant shall comply with all applicable permit requirements and shall obtain materials from a county approved source as required by the department of public works. The project applicant shall notify the department of public works when the work is to commence. After the project applicant has notified the department of public works of completion of the project and has provided certification of final quantities of materials used, the director of public works shall then inspect the work. When the director of public works has determined that the work has been satisfactorily completed, the project applicant will be reimbursed for the materials used at the approved rate, PROVIDED: that the amount of reimbursement shall not exceed the original estimate; PROVIDED FURTHER: that where unforeseen site conditions require that material in excess of that stated in the original estimate be used in order that the project be completed in a manner satisfactory to the director of public works, the amount of reimbursement may exceed the original estimate upon the recommendation of the director of public works and the approval of the council.

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(b) For projects for which application for financial assistance was made after December 1, 1986 but prior to August 12, 1987, the following procedures shall apply: The amount of financial assistance shall be based upon the determination by the director of public works of the amount of materials reasonably necessary to have been used to complete the project in a manner satisfactory to the director of public works. The department of public works shall review materials prices in order to assure that materials were obtained at competitive unit prices. The project applicant shall have complied with all applicable permit requirements and shall have obtained materials from a county approved source as required by the department of public works. After the project applicant has notified the department of public works of completion of the project and has provided certification of final quantities of materials used, the director of public works shall then inspect the work. When the director of public works has determined that the work has been satisfactorily completed, the project applicant will be reimbursed for the materials used in the amount recommended by the director of public works in accordance with this subsection and approved by the council.

Section 3. Emergency Declared. The council finds that this ordinance is necessary immediately for the support of county government and its existing public institutions and that an emergency exists. Therefore, this ordinance shall be effective immediately.


