ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR ACCOUNTING, REPORTING,  
AND COLLECTION OF ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The following new chapter is added to Title  
4 of the Snohomish County Code:

Chapter 4.11

ACCOUNTING, REPORTING, AND COLLECTION  
OF ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE

Sections:

- 4.11.010 Establishment of Procedures
- 4.11.020 Use of Collection Agencies

4.11.010 Establishment of Procedures. The director of the department of budget and finance shall establish and maintain policies and procedures relating to the accounting, reporting, and collection of accounts receivable. All county departments must comply with the policies and procedures established by the department of budget and finance upon approval of the procedures by motion of the county council.

4.11.020 Use of Collection Agencies. The director of the department of budget and finance shall establish policies and procedures governing the assignment or other referral of delinquent accounts to a collection agency that has entered into a contract with the county for that purpose. All county departments must comply with the policies and procedures

established by the department of budget and finance upon approval of the procedures by motion of the county council.
