ORDINANCE NO. 89 - 122

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY
CENTENNIAL TRAIL MATCHING FUND

WHEREAS, Snohomish County recognizes that as the county experiences accelerated growth, parks and recreational resources must be preserved and developed for the benefit of Snohomish County citizens and future generations; and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Parks and Recreation Commission, through the budgetary process, has appropriated \$1,100,000 in the State Building and Construction Account for the Snohomish Centennial Trail; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation is subject to the following conditions and limitations:

(1) The appropriation is provided solely for the Snohomish County Parks and Recreation Division to purchase and develop the railroad right-of-way from Snohomish to Arlington; and

(2) No portion of the appropriation may be expended unless an amount from non-state sources equal to the amount of the appropriation is provided for the project; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County wishes to assist in the collection and generation of these matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. A new Chapter 4.69 is added to the Snohomish County Code as follows:

Chapter 4.69

CENTENNIAL TRAIL FUND

- 4.69.010 Creation and Title
- 4.69.020 Purpose for which Fund is Created
- 4.69.030 Source of Resources
- 4.69.040 Operation of Fund
- 4.69.050 Fund Manager

4.69.010 Creation and Title. There is hereby created a cumulative reserve fund to be known as the Centennial Trail Fund.

4.69.020 Purpose for which Fund is Created. The purpose of the Centennial Trail Fund is to:

(1) Provide matching funds for the appropriation from the State of Washington Parks and Recreation Commission for the purchase and development of the right-of-way from Snohomish to Arlington to be known as the Centennial Trail as authorized by Laws of 1989, 1st Extraordinary Session, Chapter 12, Section 385.

(2) To provide a fund into which county funds, grants or other resources designated for the above-mentioned purpose can be deposited and from which expenditures can be made.

4.69.020 Source of Resources. Potential resources for the Centennial Trail Fund shall include, but not be limited to: County current expense funds, bond funds, grants, donations, gifts, bequests, collections from programs that may be established for this purpose, or other resources deemed appropriate by the county council.

4.69.040 Operation of the Fund. The operation of the Centennial Trail Fund shall be as follows:

(1) The financial resources in this cumulative reserve fund may accumulate from year to year until such time as the county council appropriates all or part of the resources in the fund for the purpose specified herein.

(2) The council may accept gifts or bequests for the Centennial Trail Fund and may make contributions to the fund from time to time in such amounts as it deems necessary to further the purpose of the fund.

(3) Any monies in said fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse nor shall the same be made available as a surplus or used for any other purpose or purposes than those specified, except as specified by state law.

4.69.050 Fund Manager. The county executive shall designate a fund manager in Parks and Recreation Division whose name and title shall appear on the master list of fund managers maintained in the Department of Budget and Finance.
