RELATING TO EXEMPT EMPLOYEES

TO ESTABLISH EXEMPT POSITIONS IN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 3.68.010 adopted by Ordinance 85-113 on November 20, 1985, last amended by Ordinance 89-172 on January 10, 1990, is amended to read as follows:

3.68.010 Scope of Chapter. The provisions of this chapter apply to the following positions:

- (1) Two positions designated by each district court judge and each superior court judge;
- (2) Two positions designated by each of the following elected officials: assessor, auditor, clerk, treasurer, prosecuting attorney and each county councilmember;
- (3) Four positions designated by the county executive;
- (4) ((The undersheriff, bureau chiefs, inspector and administrative assistant in the sheriff's office)) Six positions designated by the Sheriff in accordance with R.C.W. 41.14.070;
- (5) The department heads appointed by the executive and confirmed by the council;
- (6) The division directors and division managers and deputy department heads of executive and administrative departments whose department head is appointed by the executive and confirmed by the council: EXCEPT, that the classified employees holding such exempt positions on the effective date of this ordinance shall continue in their status as classified employees.
- (7) The professional employees within the executive's office: EXCEPT, that classified employees holding such exempt positions on the effective date of this ordinance shall continue in their status as classified employees.
- (8) Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys in the Prosecuting Attorney's Office except as provided in Snohomish County ordinances 83-147 and 85-005.
- (9) The professional employees within the County Council's Office.

Section 2. The council finds that the establishment of six exempt positions in the Sheriff's Office is necessary for the support of county government and its existing public institutions to permit the Sheriff necessary flexibility in staff appointments to respond to the public

safety needs of Snohomish County. Based on the foregoing, the council finds that an emergency exists.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
