SNOHOMISH COUNTY COUNCIL EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 91-0[1

AMENDING AMENDED ORDINANCE 90-201 WHICH RELATED TO SHORT SUBDIVISION APPROVAL REQUIREMENTS AND AMENDED SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE TITLE 20, TO RESTRICT ITS APPLICABILITY

BE IT ORDAINED:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Snohomish County Council makes the following Findings of Fact:

- (a) Ordinance 90-201 was adopted on January 2, 1991, signed by the County Executive on January 7, 1991 and, by its terms, takes effect on January 31, 1991.
- (b) Language was inadvertently included in Ordinance 90-200 which gives the ordinance broader application than that intended by the council or allowed by state law.

Section 2. Based on the foregoing Findings, Section 12 of Amended Ordinance 90-201, adopted January 7, 1991, is amended as follows:

This ordinance applies to all short subdivision applications filed on or after its effective date\_ and-shall apply-to-all-short-subdivision-applications-filed-prior-to-the effective-date-that-have-not-been-granted-conditional-and/or final-approval.

Section 3. Based on the Findings contained in Section 1 herein, the council finds as a fact that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and declares that an emergency exists. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
