EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 91-116

CODE OF ETHICS; AMENDING AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 91-084 AND
SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 2.50; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code section 2.50.050,
adopted by Ordinance 91-084 on July 1, 1991, is amended to
read:

2.50.050 Campaign Contribution Limitations. No individual, person or corporation shall make a total contribution of more than \$350 to any candidate for elected county office for a campaign for election to a particular term of office; PROVIDED, That an organized group as defined in 2.50.010((15)) (16) may contribute up to \$1,000 to a candidate for a campaign for election to a particular term of office. No candidate for elected county office shall accept or receive a campaign contribution in amounts greater than allowed by this section. Except that no candidate shall be subject to the campaign contribution limitations described in this chapter when contributing to his or her own campaign.


New Section. Section 2. A new section 2.50.700 is added to Snohomish County Code chapter 2.50 as follows:

2.50.700 Sunset. This chapter is repealed on July 1, 1997 unless reenacted prior to that date, as provided in Snohomish County Charter Section 2.115.

Section 3. Emergency declared. The council finds as a fact that revisions to Snohomish County Code chapter 2.50 are necessary and desirable to correctly reflect the council's original intent regarding campaign contribution limitations and to meet requirements of the Snohomish County Charter for sunset clause. The council further finds that it is necessary that these revisions be made prior to the August 1, 1991 effective date of chapter 2.50 and that insufficient time exists to provide for notice and hearing on these revisions prior to that date. The council further finds that the revisions to chapter 2.50 contained in this ordinance are necessary for the support of county government and its existing public institutions. Based upon the foregoing, the council declares that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
