EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 92 - 084

ADOPTING NEW VOTING PRECINCTS FOR SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND
DELEGATING AUTHORITY FOR SUBSEQUENT CHANGES TO COUNTY AUDITOR;
AMENDING SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE TITLE 2

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. A new chapter is added to Title 2 of the Snohomish Code to read:

Snohomish County Voting Precincts

- 2.47.010 Purpose
- 2.47.020 Authority
- 2.47.030 Precincts Adopted
- 2.47.040 Delegation of Authority to Create, Dissolve, and/or Alter Precincts.

Section 2.47.010 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to adopt new precinct lines for all of Snohomish County created as a result of redistricting pursuant to the 1990 federal census.

Section 2.47.020 Authority. Pursuant to RCW 29.04.040, RCW 29.04.050 and RCW 29.70.100, all precinct lines are to follow census tract and block lines whenever possible. Pursuant to RCW 29.04.050 and RCW 3.38.050 no precinct line may be dissected by a congressional district, legislative district, council district or district court district line.

Section 2.47.030 Precincts Adopted. The precinct lines as drawn by the County Auditor's office to bring all precincts in Snohomish County into conformance with federal census tract and block lines are set forth in precinct map books on file with the Clerk of the Council and the Snohomish County Auditor's office and hereby adopted as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2.47.040 Delegation of Authority to Create, Dissolve and/or Alter Precincts. The County Auditor has the responsibility as set forth in RCW 29.04.040 and RCW 29.04.050 to create, dissolve or otherwise alter voting precincts in order to maintain conformance with applicable state laws and to further the efficient administration of elections and voter registration within Snohomish County. Revisions made in voting precincts will be submitted to the County Council for approval by motion by June 1 of the applicable year.

Section 2. The county council finds as a fact that this ordinance is necessary to comply with the redistricting process and specifically RCW 29.04.040 which requires precinct boundaries to be approved and unchanged from 30 days before filing through the general election and that this ordinance is necessary for the support of county government and its existing public institutions. Based on the foregoing, the county council declares that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
