ORDINANCE NO. 92-149
AMENDING
MISCELLANEOUS PERMIT FEES;
AMENDING SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE TITLE 29

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 29.12.010, last amended by Ordinance No. 91-173 on November 26, 1991, is **AMENDED** to read:

29.12.010 Application. A boundary line adjustment application shall be on forms supplied by the department, shall be signed by the owners of all interests in the property, and shall be accompanied by:

(1) An 8 1/2 x 11 inch or 8 1/2 by 14 inch plot plan depicting both existing boundary lines and proposed boundary line changes drawn at a scale not to exceed 1 inch = 50 feet, or at a scale agreed upon by the applicant and the director;

(2) Legal descriptions of the revised lots, tracts, parcels, sites or divisions certified by a licensed surveyor or title company((-));

(3) A filing fee of (~~one hundred seventy five~~) two hundred dollars (~~shall be~~) paid to the department for approval of a boundary line adjustment application((-)); and

(4) A signed form, supplied by the department, identifying what lot or lots, if any, may be developed with a duplex structure. Failure to disclose the intent to develop a lot or lots with duplexes is subject to the provisions of SCC 29.20.030.
