EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 92-160

AMENDING CHAPTER 3.68 OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE  
TO ESTABLISH LEAVE BENEFITS FOR SUPERIOR COURT  
LAW CLERKS/BAILIFFS

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 3.68.010 added by Ordinance No. 85-113, Section 2, November 20, 1985, and last amended by Ordinance No. 91-118, August 28, 1991, is amended to read as follows:

3.68.010 Scope of chapter. The provisions of this chapter apply to the following positions:

- (1) Two positions designated by each district court judge;
- (2) Two positions designated by each of the following elected officials: assessor, auditor, clerk, treasurer, prosecuting attorney, and each county council member;
- (3) Four positions designated by the county executive;
- (4) Six positions designated by the sheriff in accordance with RCW 41.14.070;
- (5) The department heads appointed by the executive and confirmed by the council;
- (6) The division directors and division managers and deputy department heads of executive and administrative departments whose department head is appointed by the executive and confirmed by the council;
- (7) The professional employees within the executive's office;
- (8) Deputy prosecuting attorneys in the prosecuting attorney's office as provided in Snohomish County Ordinance No. 83-147;
- (9) The professional employees within the county council office;
- (10) Two positions designated by each superior court judge, the superior court administrator, the assistant superior court administrator, and the juvenile court administrator, except that no law clerk/bailiff hired and designated pursuant to this chapter subsequent to December 31, 1992, shall be entitled to the leave benefits conferred by this chapter, but instead they shall receive, use and accrue vacation, sick and holiday benefits

in accordance with chapter 3A.06 of the Snohomish County Code;

- (11) The hearing examiner and any deputy examiners selected and appointed pursuant to SCC 2.02.030 and 2.02.040;
- (12) Any classified employee transferred, reclassified or promoted to an exempt position on or after the effective date of this subsection.

Section 2. The county council finds as a fact that, for purposes of leave benefits, superior court law clerks/bailiffs hold a status similar to classified employees and that the leave benefits for exempt employees are inappropriate for law clerks/bailiffs. It is necessary to pass this ordinance as an emergency so that any new law clerks/bailiffs appointed in fiscal 1993 shall be accorded appropriate leave benefits and this ordinance is necessary for the support of county government and its existing public institutions. Based on the foregoing, the county council declares that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
