## ORDINANCE NO. 93- /27 AMENDING MISCELLANEOUS PERMIT FEES; AMENDING SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE TITLE 29

## **BE IT ORDAINED:**

**SECTION 1**. Snohomish County Code, Title 29, section 29.12.010, last amended by Ordinance 92-149 on November 24, 1992, is **AMENDED** to read:

- 29.12.010 Application. A boundary line adjustment application shall be on forms supplied by the department, shall be signed by the owners of all interests in the property, and shall be accompanied by:
- (1) An 8  $1/2 \times 11$  inch or 8  $1/2 \times 14$  inch plot plan depicting both existing boundary lines and proposed boundary line changes drawn at a scale not to exceed 1 inch = 50 feet, or at a scale agreed upon by the applicant and the director;
- (2) Legal descriptions of the revised lots, tracts, parcels, sites, or divisions certified by a licensed surveyor or title company;
- (3) A filing fee of two hundred <u>fifty</u> dollars paid to the department for approval of a boundary line adjustment application; and
- (4) A signed form, supplied by the department, identifying what lot or lots, if any, may be developed with a duplex structure. Failure to disclose the intent to develop a lot or lots with duplexes is subject to the provisions of SCC 29.20.030.
