AMENDING CHAPTER 2.15 SCC RELATING TO  
THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.15.030, last amended by Ordinance 82-125 on December 16, 1987, is amended to read:

**2.15.030 Responsibilities.**

The director of the department of corrections is in charge of all adult correctional institutions and programs of the county, and all persons confined therein or those subject to such programs. The director will manage, operate and control such institutions and programs in compliance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, including keeping of a jail register as required by RCW 70.48.100. ~~((Until such time as the council shall adopt specific local standards for the operation of the county corrections facilities as required by chapter 462, section 17, laws of 1987, the))~~ The director shall operate the facilities in compliance with the operating standards ~~((in chapters 289-02, 10, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20, 22, 24, 26 and 28 WAC as they existed on December 16, 1987 which are incorporated herein by this reference. These standards shall continue in effect notwithstanding any repeal or invalidation of the Washington Administrative code provisions due to the elimination of the state corrections standards board by chapter 462, section 21, laws of 1987.))~~ contained in Title 5, Snohomish County Code.

Section 2. A new section is added to Chapter 2.15 of the Snohomish County Code to read:

**2.15.034 Assigned Counsel Program.**

In addition to the responsibilities of the department of corrections set forth in SCC 2.15.030, the department shall administer an assigned counsel program and is hereby authorized and empowered to maintain a centrally administered system for the assignment of counsel to represent indigent defendants, to develop criteria for assignment of counsel, to administer programs, and to recommend entry into contracts with private nonprofit corporations offering public defender services.

~~((Section 3. A new section is added to Chapter 2.15 of the Snohomish County Code to read:~~

**2.15.035 Court Security Program**


~~In addition to the responsibilities of the department of corrections set forth in SGC 2.15.030, the department shall administer a security program for county buildings and is hereby authorized and empowered to maintain a centrally administered system for the operation of program components, including, but not limited to employment and deployment of security officers, weapons screening devices, access control equipment at designated county buildings; and development, dissemination and enforcement of security rules and procedures.))~~

Section ((4)) 3. Snohomish County Code Section 2.15.035, last amended by Ordinance 87-125 on December 16, 1987, is repealed.

Section ((5)) 4. Snohomish County Code Section 2.15.065, last amended by Ordinance 87-125 on December 16, 1987, is repealed.


