ORDINANCE NO. 97-<u>09</u>7

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO COURTS OF LIMITED JURISDICTION INCLUDING JUSTICE AND DISTRICT COURTS, PROVIDING FOR A SINGLE DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT WITH SEPARATE ELECTORAL DISTRICTS, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2.12 SCC

#### BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Purpose and findings. (1) The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a unified county-wide district court with separate electoral districts as authorized by RCW 3.38.070, to provide for its administration, and to make other amendments to the districting plan adopted pursuant to Chapter 3.38 RCW. In establishing a single district court district the County Council intends to promote a more efficient and cost-effective system of justice. While respecting the constitutional separation of powers, the Council encourages the district court to adopt local court rules that apply throughout the district and to develop and implement administrative procedures that will promote the equitable assignment of cases and realize cost savings through centralization and consolidation of functions, facilities, and personnel.

(2) The Council finds that consolidation of existing district court districts was recommended by the districting committee established under RCW 3.38.010 on July 17, 1997. The Council further finds that the districting plan, as amended by this ordinance, conforms to the standards set forth in Chapters 3.30 through 3.74 RCW and is conducive to the best interests and welfare of the county as a whole.

<u>Section 2.</u> The chapter heading of Chapter 2.12 of the Snohomish County Code, as adopted by the Code Reviser, is amended to read:

#### Chapter 2.12 ((JUSTICE)) DISTRICT COURT

Section 3. A new section is added to Chapter 2.12 of the Snohomish County Code to read:

**2.12.015 District Court District Established.** (1) There is hereby established a single district court in Snohomish County, to be known as the Snohomish county district court. The boundaries of the district court district shall be the boundaries of the county, except that the district shall not include any portion of the county that is within the joint district court district described in SCC 2.12.055.

(2) The district court district shall be divided into four electoral districts for the purpose of electing district court judges by subcounty local districts as provided in RCW 3.38.070. District court judges having the qualifications set out in RCW 3.34.060 shall be elected pursuant to RCW 3.34.050 by registered voters of the electoral districts for which they file declarations of candidacy. The boundaries of the electoral districts are described in SCC 2.12.020, 2.12.030, 2.12.040, and 2.12.050.

<u>Section 4.</u> Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.020, last amended by Ordinance No. 94-063 on July 20, 1994, is amended to read:

### 2.12.020 Cascade ((District)) electoral district boundaries.

((<del>(1)</del>)) The ((<del>justice court</del>)) <u>electoral</u> district in north Snohomish county, known as "Cascade <u>Electoral</u> District," shall ((<del>be revised to</del>)) include all the land lying within the following voting precincts. <u>Section 9.</u> Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.060, adopted by Ordinance No. 89-041 on May 24, 1989, is amended to read:

# 2.12.060 Adjustment of ((district)) precinct boundaries following annexations.

In order to meet the ((requirements)) requirement of ((RCW 3.38.050(5))) RCW 3.38.050(4) that a district court district boundary not intersect the boundary of an election precinct, the county auditor shall temporarily adjust ((district and)) precinct boundaries as necessary when a city annexes county territory to the city ((... Such adjustments shall be made)) in accordance with RCW 29.04.040(5) ((as soon as possible after the approval of the annexation)). ((The temporary adjustment shall be limited to the minimum changes necessary to accommodate the addition of the territory to the city and shall remain in effect only until district and precinct boundary modifications reflecting the annexation are adopted by the county legislative authority.)) The auditor shall report such precinct boundary adjustments to the county council, prosecuting attorney, and district court presiding judge.

Section 10. Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.070, last amended by Ordinance No. 89-041 on May 24, 1989, is amended to read:

### 2.12.070 Number of judges ((per district)).

- (1) There shall be seven full-time judges elected in the district court district established by this chapter.
- (2) The number of judges to be elected in each <u>electoral</u> district shall be as follows:

Cascade -- one full-time judge; Evergreen -- one full-time judge; Everett -- two full-time judges; South -- three full-time judges,

Section 11. Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.080, last amended by Ordinance No. 89-041 on May 24, 1989, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

### 2.12.080 Location of offices and courtrooms.

The offices and courtrooms of the district court shall be located at the county courthouse in Everett, Washington; the county court facility in Arlington, Washington; the county court facility in Monroe, Washington; the county court facility in Lynnwood, Washington; and at such other locations as may be determined appropriate by the presiding judge.

<u>Section 12.</u> Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.100, adopted by Resolution on June 13, 1966, is amended to read:

# 2.12.100 ((Number)) <u>Authorization</u> of court commissioners ((per district -- Location)).

The district court s authorized to appoint one or more district court commissioners, subject to appropriation of necessary funds pursuant to chapter 4.26 SCC. ((Justice)) District court commissioners ((shall)) may be ((authorized for)) located in ((each)) any electoral district as determined by the presiding judge. ((Follows:

Cascade District Five commissioners, one of which may be the clerk
To be located at: Arlington, Darrington, Granite Falls, Stanwood

<u>Section 13.</u> Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.120, adopted by Resolution on June 13, 1966, is amended to read:

### 2.12.120 Salaries of municipal ((justices)) judges.

((There will be no allocations made in any district)) The county will not make payments to cities for the salaries of municipal judges.

Section 14. A new section is added to Chapter 2.12 of the Snohomish County Code to read:

### 2.12.125 Presiding judge.

The business of the district court shall be supervised by a presiding judge selected pursuant to Rule 5 of the Administrative Rules for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction (ARLJ). The duties of the presiding judge are set out in ARLJ 5(b).

Section 15. A new section is added to Chapter 2.12 of the Snohomish County Code to read:

#### 2.12.135 Division of probation.

There is established within the district court a division of probation which shall be responsible for providing probation services to the district court. The division of probation shall be supervised by the presiding judge.

<u>Section 16.</u> Snohomish County Code Sections 2.12.010, 2.12.090, and 2.12.130, adopted by Resolution on June 13, 1966, are repealed.

<u>Section 17.</u> Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.131, adopted by Resolution on December 10, 1973, is repealed.

<u>Section 18.</u> Snohomish County Code Sections 2.12.011, 2.12.012, 2.12.013, 2.12.110, and 2.12.140, last amended by Amended Ordinance No. 89-041 on May 24, 1989, are repealed.

Section 19. Savings and transition. (1) The justice court districts known as the Cascade District, Evergreen District, Everett District, and South District shall be dissolved upon establishment of the Snohomish County District Court on January 10, 1999. All rights and responsibilities of those justice courts shall be transferred to the Snohomish County District Court.

- (2) This ordinance shall not have the effect of terminating or in any way modifying any right, liability, or judicial proceeding, civil or criminal, that is in existence upon establishment of the Snohomish County District Court on January 10, 1999, except insofar as may be necessary to effectuate the transfer of rights and responsibilities of the justice courts identified in subsection 1 of this section to the district court. Nothing in this ordinance shall impair the rights of any party arising out of a collective bargaining agreement or the county personnel rules.
- (3) The county auditor shall accept declarations of candidacy for the district court judge positions created by this ordinance during the filing period provided by law prior to the general election held in November, 1998. The district court judge positions

created by this ordinance shall be filled by persons who are elected in the general election held in November, 1998.

<u>Section 20.</u> <u>Effective dates.</u> Sections 1 though 18 of this ordinance shall take effect on January 10, 1999. Section 19 of this ordinance shall take effect ten days after it is signed by the county executive or otherwise enacted, as provided in section 2.110 of the county charter.
