ORDINANCE NO. 98 - 024

AMENDING SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 2.12  
RELATING TO THE NUMBER OF DISTRICT COURT JUDGES

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.12.070, last amended by Ordinance No. 97-097 on December 10, 1997, is amended to read:

2.12.070 Number of judges.

- (1) There shall be ~~((seven))~~ eight full-time judges elected in the district court district established by this chapter.
- (2) The number of judges to be elected in each electoral district shall be as follows:
  - Cascade -- one full-time judge;
  - Evergreen -- ~~((one))~~ two full-time ~~((judge))~~ judges;
  - Everett -- two full-time judges;
  - South -- three full-time judges.

Section 2. Transition. The county auditor shall accept declarations of candidacy for the district court judge position created by this ordinance during the filing period provided by law prior to the general election held in November, 1998. The district court judge position created by this ordinance shall be filled by a person who is elected in the general election held in November, 1998.

Section 3. Effective dates. Section 1 of this ordinance shall take effect on January 10, 1999. Section 2 of this ordinance shall take effect ten days after it is signed by the County Executive or otherwise enacted, as provided in Section 2.110 of the county charter.
